- D. If this puppy receives any vaccinations or worming medications during this time or before "next due", it will render this guarantee null and void.
 - a. Puppy was last vaccinated and wormed on _____ for Parvo, Distemper, Parainfluenza and both types of Adenovirus (DA2PPv) with and is not due again until _____
 - b. If buyer lets any veterinarian bully them into getting vaccinations before they are due without a titer test proving the booster is needed for proper immunity, the health guarantee will be rendered null and void.

Exclusions of Health Guarantees

- A. Seller will not be responsible for any veterinary, travel or treatment expenses of any kind, including those related to returning a puppy to buyer or sending a replacement.
- B. These guarantees do not include effects of aging, parasites, allergies, nutrition, neglect, abuse or polygenic traits.
- C. These guarantees do not include any adverse reactions or side effects of any vaccines administered during the initial vet visit or at any other time.
- D. This guarantee does not include any illness caused by or effects of any misdiagnose or mistakes in treatment or death caused by any vet or veterinary treatment
- E. Seller is not responsible for any accident or injury that occurs after the puppy/dog has left the seller's possession.

Terms of Sale

- B. In the event this dog needs to be rehomed for any reason:

Puppy's Age	Recommended Vaccinations	Optional Vaccinations
6 – 8 weeks	Distemper, parvovirus	Bordetella
10 – 12 weeks	DHPP (vaccines for distemper, adenovirus [hepatitis], parainfluenza, and parvovirus)	Influenza, Leptospirosis, Bordetella, Lyme disease per lifestyle as recommended by veterinarian
16 – 18 weeks	DHPP, rabies	Influenza, Lyme disease, Leptospirosis, Bordetella per lifestyle
12 – 16 months	DHPP, rabies	Coronavirus, Leptospirosis, Bordetella, Lyme disease
Every 1 – 2 years	DHPP	Influenza, Coronavirus, Leptospirosis, Bordetella, Lyme disease per lifestyle
